



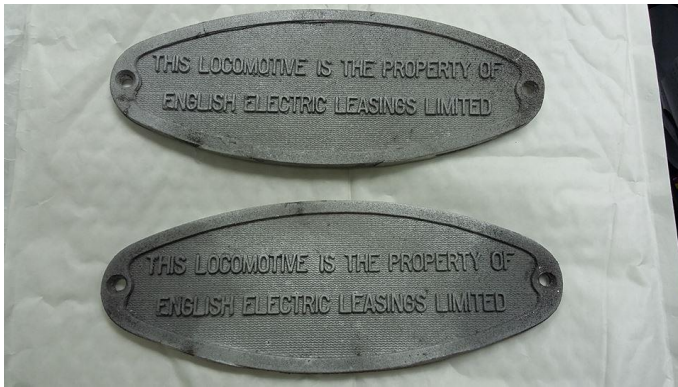

D402 received another small part in the return to original condition with the purchase from the Fifty Fund of replica leasing plates.



Work on 6737 progressed to completion the cleaning and painting of the main and auxiliary generators including the casings themselves.

The tool van has been completely reorganised, once all the stores had been removed

the van was sectioned into areas of ready use stores, workbench and cleaning areas. All tools have been accounted for and stored in easy access cupboards or shelving which have been clearly marked, this in itself will assist

the working members and allow them to be more productive over the working weekends.
